CAEN, 1000 YEARS OF HISTORY

The city boasts a rich historical heritage: from William the Conqueror to the Battle of Normandy.

Caen

Over the centuries, the city has been marked by major historical events: from William the Conqueror, whose legacy is none other than Caen's three landmark sites (i.e. the castle and the two abbeys), to the Battle of Normandy, which left the city scarred, luckily sparing a few Middle-Ages and Renaissance gems.

The Caen Memorial Museum

Visit the museum and relive the major events of the 20th century: from the outbreak of WWII to the end of the Cold War. D-Day and the Battle of Normandy are the main features of the museum. Plunge into European history from 1900 to 1991 with the 19-minute circular screen movie experience.



Ornavik

Follow the guide and set off to see the Carolingian village and the Viking trading post. Enjoy an enriching and interactive experience, and find out more about the daily lives of people in the 10th century. Ornavik is a chance to understand how Normandy was born, between the Viking Rollo and William the Conqueror, and most of all to experience it!

Caen

The commented panoramic tour of Caen by little train allows you to discover the main emblematic sites of the city: the castle, the Ladies' Abbey, the marina, the Men's Abbey and the historic centre. To overcome the frustration of not entering these monuments, we suggest you a guided tour of the Men's Abbey, a jewel of Norman Romanesque architecture and current seat of the town hall.

Possible options : tripe tasting or visit of the Fabrique à Biscuits (in the morning)

This price includes:

The entrance at Ornavik Park (Avril to September), lunch including a 3-course menu and a drinks package (1/4 wine, coffee), the commented ride on the little train (April-September) and the guided tour of the Men's Abbey.

Ride on the city tour train, lunch - 3-course meal and drinks (25 cl pitcher of wine and coffee) - and a guide to show you around Ouistreham. We invite you to discover the port and learn about its various activities: yachting, trade, cross-Channel activity and fishing. Option: climb to the top of the Ouistreham lighthouse (38 m high, 171 steps) for a breathtaking 360° view of the seaside resort.

Seafront Villas

The Caen la mer coastline is shared between 4 resorts with 10 km of fine sandy beaches. Beautiful villas in the eclectic architectural style so typical of the Normandy coastline line the beach and invite you to take a stroll.

The guide for the visit of the harbour and the seafront villas, lunch including a 3-course menu and a drinks package.

Caen

The city has been shaped by the centuries and its tumultuous history: from William the Conqueror, who gave the city its three iconic sites, the castle and the two abbeys, to the Battle of Normandy, which changed the face of the city, while leaving intact a few of the treasures from the Middle Ages and the Renaissance.

Visit to a cider farm: A tour from the orchards to the maturing cellar before tasting Normandy's famous elixir, Calvados.

Bayeux

The medieval town was spared bombardment and is famous for its magnificent cathedral, its preserved town centre and the Tapestry, 70 m long, and dating from the 11th century, recounting William the Conqueror's invasion of England. This unique masterpiece is listed in UNESCO's Memory of the World Register.

The price includes:

Sightseeing train trip in Caen, tour and tasting at the cider farm, lunch including a 3-course menu and drinks (1/4 litre of wine, coffee) and the guided tour of Bayeux (the Tapestry as an option).

The price does not include: Travel by coach, personal spending, extra drinks and items not included in the menu, as well as any other service not explicitly mentioned in the programme. Please note.

Maximum capacity on sightseeing train: 45 people. The sightseeing train is open from April to September.

The trip in the sightseeing train can be replaced by a guided tour of the city. The timetable is given for information purposes. This schedule can be followed on any day, subject to availability.

A day trip in Normandy to historical must-see sites...

Caen Memorial

The museum helps you experience the history of the 20th century, from the origins of the Second World War to the end of the Cold War. A large space is dedicated to D-Day and the Battle of Normandy.

OR

Arromanches Museum

This was the first museum opened on the D-Day theme after the Second World War. It shows how Mulberry B Harbour was built, while the remains of the real harbour can still be seen just outside the museum. The museum moved into a new building in 2023.

The Normandy Landings beaches

This is a chance to see the main sites where the fate of the country played out on 6 June 1944: the Mulberry Harbour in Arromanches, the German battery in Longues-sur-Mer, the US cemetery in Colleville-sur-Mer and Omaha Beach

The price includes:

2 guides for the visit of the Caen Memorial Museum or 1 guide for the Arromanches Museum, 1 guide for the landing beaches, admission to the Caen Memorial Museum or Arromanches Museum and lunch: 3-course menu and drinks (25 cl pitcher of wine and coffee).

The price does not include: Coach travel, personal expenses, extra drinks and any extras not on the menu, as well as any other service not listed on this programme.

The visit to the Caen Memorial Museum can be replaced by a guided tour of Caen or Bayeux.

SPECIAL DAY SWORD BEACH

See the little-known D-Day sites close to Caen...

Sword Beach

This was one of the five iconic D-Day beaches, where 177 French soldiers from the Kieffer commando unit landed.

The British cemetery in Hermanville-sur-Mer

1,005 Allied soldiers are buried in the British cemetery. Most of the soldiers died on 6 June or on the days following the D-Day landings.

The Hillman site

The 24-hectare site with 18 bunkers and underground structures was built by the Germans between 1942 and 1944. It was the command post for their coastal defences on the Côte de Nacre.

The Grand Bunker

The Atlantic Wall Museum is housed in the former headquarters of the German army commanding the batteries in the Orne estuary. The tower was made from 5,000 tons of concrete and steel, and was unique in its kind. Standing 17 metres high and with 6 storeys, it looked down on the villas in Riva-Bella. It has been restored to show how it looked before 6 June 1944.

The price includes:

The services of a guide for the tour of Sword Beach and the British cemetery, admission to the Hillman Site or the Grand Bunker and lunch including a 3-course menu and drinks (1/4 litre of wine, coffee).

The price does not include: Travel by coach, personal spending, extra drinks and items not included in the menu, as well as any other service not explicitly mentioned in the programme.

DAY TRIP IN THE HEART **OF NORMANDY**

FROM €56 PER PERSON (BASED ON A GROUP OF 30)

A day-trip to take in Normandy's signature rolling landscapes and local products

Food tasting visit to choose from:

- Option 1: Graindorge Cheese Dairy Audioguided tour of the workshops seen through glass galleries, followed by cheese tasting
- Option 2: Calvados Drouin
 An authentic, traditional distillery on a historic estate with typical Pays d'Auge architecture dating from the 17th century (visit and tasting).

Honfleur and the Côte Fleurie

Honfleur is known in particular as the city of painters and impressionism (with its old cobbled streets, its rich architectural heritage, the old port (le Vieux Bassin) and iconic half-timbered houses, etc.).

Different activities to choose from:

- Choice 1: Commented boat cruise along the Estuary of the Seine with a passage under the bridge Pont de Normandie
- Choice 2: Visit of the Mora with an immersive journey through 1,000 years of maritime history and a reconstruction site of William the Conqueror's flagship La Mora using the techniques of the 11th century.

The price includes:

Admission and tasting in one of the chosen sites, lunch including a 3-course menu and drinks (1/4 litre of wine, coffee) and one of the two activities proposed in the afternoon (La Mora or the boat cruise).

The price does not include: Coach travel, personal expenses, extra drinks and any extras not on the menu, as well as any other service not listed on this programme. Note
